CHRP, through the School of Behavioural and Social Sciences and Humanities, offers a scholarship to undertake doctoral research on family relationships.

Centacare Ballarat (lead partner), Child and Family Services Ballarat and Relationships Australia have obtained funding through the Attorney-General's Department and the Department of Families, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs to operate a Family Relationship Centre (FRC) based in Ballarat. The Centre becomes operational in July 2007.

A three-year scholarship is offered for a full-time student to undertake research and evaluation in service systems associated with the delivery of services through the Centre.

The student will have an opportunity to make a significant contribution to knowledge in this field, and will build strong linkages with other researchers in government departments and the Institute of Family Studies. Office accommodation will be provided for the student at both the FRC and the School of Behavioural and Social Sciences and Humanities. Academic supervision will be provided by staff within the School of BSSH.
